

Bick's Driving School - Behind the Wheel Lessons

These are helpful things to know about the lessons before starting with us. Remember, this is to help you become a safe and effective driver; we don't expect you to know it all, but we want a safe learning environment.

1. Communicate openly with your instructor; all questions are encouraged.
2. Remember: this is just training. We are not testing you. The BMV will test you for your license after you've completed all of your training.
3. Address scheduling issues only with the office (513-931-6200); instructors cannot approve changes.
4. If meeting at the office, wait outside our office door or in your vehicle. Your instructor will contact you if they are late.
5. For home pickups, be ready 30 minutes early. Instructors usually honk from the driveway rather than calling or texting but will text or call if necessary.
6. Always adhere to the speed limit; do not exceed it. You will fail the driving exam if you go 5 over. Treat this practice like you would on your driving test.
7. Ensure you know your left from right. Use markings on your hands if necessary.
8. Come to a full stop before shifting gears to prevent transmission damage.
9. Brake when your instructor uses their dual brake.
10. Do not resist if the instructor assists with steering for safety.
11. Familiarize yourself with vehicle controls at home first.
12. Certificates of Completion and parent reports are emailed within five business days.
13. Physical temporary permits must be present; digital copies are not accepted. Missing permits incur a fee.
14. We use "piggybacking," where students drive others to their next location. All instructors are state-licensed and prioritize safety.
15. Crocs and sandals are prohibited for safety. Wear closed toed gym shoes.
16. Driving tests require the Certificate of Completion, issued and emailed the following business day.
17. Log 50 hours of driving with a guardian; the required affidavit is at www.bickscolerain.com or the BMV.
